



HOW TO BLOW BUBBLES IN A BUBBLE

Materials required:

- > Suitably sized container
- > Bubble wand (make your own out of the included coat hanger)

Bubble solution:

- > 6 cups water
- > 1 cup dish soap

Instructions:

Make bubble wand:

1. Unfold the coat hanger, then bend one end into a circle, around 15cm in diameter.
2. Secure the circle by twisting the wire around the straight piece of wire.
3. Make a handle out of the remaining wire, so you have a loop with a handle.

Make bubble solution:

1. Pour 6 cups of water into the container.
2. Pour 1 cup of dish soap into the water and slowly stir. Do not let foam or bubbles form.

Blowing bubbles in a bubble:

1. Carefully dunk wand into bubble solution.
2. Create a bubble and catch it on the wand.
3. Blow on the bubble with a few short, sharp breaths.
4. There are now smaller bubbles inside the original bubble.
